FREIGHTER INDRA CARRIES COTTON FOR JAPAN

One of the largest shipments of cotton to leave the Southern states for the Far East and to pass through Honolulu is on board the big Indra line freighter Indrakula, an arrival from Panama canal yesterday.

GERMANS RECEIVE STEAMER LURLINE IS A FLOATING BARNYARD

The local German colony and officers and men from visiting vessels flying the Teuton colors gathered in force at Pier 7 before the Pacific Mail liner Korea, with about 100 refugees from Tsingtau and the Marshall islands resumed the voyage to the mainland at 10 o'clock this morning.

A medley likened to that coming from a well-regulated barnyard greeted a delegation of federal quarantine, immigration and customs officers who boarded the Matsuo Navigation steamer Lurline on arrival from San Francisco this morning.

According to a statement issued by the foreign trade department of the Chamber of Commerce, the cargo tonnage that passed through the Panama canal during November east bound was 242,762 tons.

Mauna Kea Passes Coasters.

Several inter-island coasters employed in the movement of sugar from Hawaii ports to Hilo were passed by the flagship Mauna Kea in returning to Honolulu.

Hawaii Sugar Report.

Additional shipments of sugar are reported at plantations on the island of Hawaii by Purser Phillips of the steamer Mauna Kea, which arrived this morning.

Steaming for San Francisco at 10 o'clock tomorrow morning the Matson liner Matsonia will carry the next outgoing mail for the mainland.

Twenty-three days from Grays Harbor, the schooner Espada is due daily at Kahului, Maui. The vessel has been chartered to carry a cargo of lumber.

The schooner Okanogan, with a cargo of lumber for Honolulu, is reported one of the latest departures from Port Gamble. The vessel is due here early in February.

The schooner Blakeley is one of the vessels predicted to be an early arrival at the port from Port Blakeley. The vessel was supplied with a shipment of lumber.

A large cargo of lumber from the north Pacific coast is on the way to Port Allen, Kauai, in the schooner Oceanic Vance. The vessel left Port Angeles 17 days ago.

The American barkentine Georgina, with a full cargo of nitrates from Chilean coast ports, is out 34 days from Antofagasta. The vessel is expected here the middle part of February.

Consigned to importers at Hilo the schooner Camano, with a shipment of lumber, left Port Ludlow 26 days ago. Officers in the Mauna Kea failed to sight this vessel in steaming from Hilo for Honolulu.

Steaming from Liverpool and United Kingdom ports with a general cargo, to call at ports along the west coast of South and Central America, the Harrison Direct Line steamer Director is expected to arrive here the latter part of February.

Steaming from Honolulu on January 1, taking ballast only, the British freighter Strathardle is reported to have arrived at Eureka, Cal., last Saturday. The Strathardle is understood to have been chartered to load a shipment of lumber for Australia.
