ANOTHER BAR UP ON CHINESE

WASHINGTON, D. C., Jan. 31.—Senator Jones of Washington today introduced a bill which provides that no Chinese or person of Chinese descent, who crosses the Pacific ocean with the purpose, immediate or ultimate, of entering or reentering the United States, except Chinese diplomatic consular officers and their attendants, shall land in the United States elsewhere than at such specific ports as may be designated by the Secretary of Commerce and Labor. Provision is also made that if any such person shall enter the United States without being inspected and admitted by the United States immigration officers at said ports he shall be deported to the trans-Pacific country whence he came.
