## BUSINESS MEN'S CLUB IS PLANNED BY Y. M. C. A.

Following the lines adopted at Denver, Columbus, and many of the other cities on the mainland the local Y. M. C. A. is planning to run a business men's club in connection with the new building. Lockers have been provided for a hundred and one of the handball courts will be reserved during certain hours of the afternoon.

The lockers will be of an extra large size and will be in a room in the basement which will also be fitted out with cold water showers. In addition to this there will be a room for reading and lounging.

There will be special classes held every afternoon probably between the hours of 4:30 p. m. and 6 p. m. A special gymnasium class will be held during three afternoons through the week.

The system has worked well in other cities and those in charge here see no reason why it should not also catch on under local conditions. It is sometimes slow in becoming popular but once it is properly started then there is always a waiting list. The above plans are only tentative and may be altered slightly before the opening comes around.
