

**COUNTY FARM BUREAU  
MAKES BIG SHOWING**

The Twin Falls County Farm Bureau has accomplished many things during 1919. The bureau has conducted a number of grain grading schools. It has been a great benefit to the farmers of the tract by finding markets for their produce, securing workers for them as well as working hard to rid their fruit trees of the pests so common in most sections of the country. In addition to these things the bureau has brought numerous specialists from the state university here to acquaint the farmers with the latest methods of agriculture. The colleges are constantly finding out new and beneficial things about farming and imparting that knowledge to the farmers. Thousands of squirrels, sparrows and other pests have been poisoned under the supervision of the bureau.

Miss Edna Ludwig has assisted the county women in making dress forms, thereby saving the county approximately \$3,000. The cleaning of materials as well as the making of garments has been carried on. The Child Welfare department is proving very successful. Mothers are learning the proper foods for their children and hot lunches are being served to the students of a great many of the rural schools.

The Farm Bureau Junior work has been carried on under the leadership of County Leader A. I. O'Reilly. There have been about 10 clubs formed and the work done has been of a high grade. Prize winners have been announced and Mr. O'Reilly is looking forward to the continuation of club work next year.

The Farm Bureau Junior work is a division of the Farm Bureau under the leadership of the County Club Leader, maintained for the purpose of encouraging and training the rural boys and girls in farm life.

Following results have been accomplished during the past year:

204 boys and girls enrolled; 645 bushels corn raised; 1038 bushels potatoes raised; 2068 quarts vegetables, fruits, etc., canned; 1121 chickens raised; 63,960 pounds sugar beets raised; 234 articles sewing made; 19,240 pounds beans raised; 37 sheep raised; 4 pure bred calves raised; 7644 pounds pork produced. The actual value of the products by the boys and girls is \$8,593.92.
