

THE TOWN OF BURR OAK

This town has an elevator with a capacity of 6000 bushels and cement works were established this fall by David Murray, a local man. The farming district around Burr Oak is particularly good.

The crops on the average this year were not considered good by the farmers. Corn, they say, was very poor in the vicinity of Burr Oak, and the wheat crop only averaged 16 bushels to the acre. Potatoes were a good crop for those who tended them, but the want of rain during the early summer season prevented the crop from materializing anything out of the ordinary. The lumber flats, from which the town derived its name, are now almost depleted of timber, but the soil is said to be of the very best for cultivation.

Burr Oak has two churches and good schools. The big general store kept and owned by J. W. Currens, is one of the best and most complete in the county, and Mr. Currens is an enterprising townsman.

United States Department of Agriculture, the various state experimental stations and college departments of agronomy, are doing a wonderful work in the matter of educating the farmer. One of the latest announcements is the discovery of an effective method for suppressing weeds without resorting to the laborious process of hand-pulling.

The Agricultural Department of the University of Wisconsin, while conducting a series of tests in hemp-growing, found that the crop's greatest weakness was in eradicating weeds. Some of the experimental plots this year on land worked by the university were badly infected with quack grass, Canada thistles, wild mustard and other deep-rooted weeds. These plots were sown in hemp, which grew to a height of 10 or 12 feet. It may have been the rank growth of the hemp or the deprivation of sunlight, but when the land was broken after the crop was removed, it was found that nearly all of the weed roots had been killed. A university bulletin makes the announcement of the facts in the case, and adds that weedy ground does not affect the growth of hemp.

But the most important fact in connection with the matter is that it pays to grow hemp—at least in Wisconsin, so that the farmer can get a profit from his land at the same time he is getting rid of one of his worst enemies. On a four-acre field about 1,000 pounds of fiber were secured. The fiber brings seven cents a pound or \$70 an acre, and the labor of producing it costs about \$20, leaving a balance of \$50.
