Police separated the struggling men and taking Lindsey in custody, police carried him to St. Francis Hospital for treatment. He refused treatment there, and was then taken to Cook County

Hospital, where he was treated and then carried to the County jail, where he will await trial until November 5, 1957.

On the same night, Ronald C. Harmon, 24, of 3720 West 142nd street, Robbins, was picked up on the streets of Blue Island and questioned by the police. He admitted being with Lindsey and police charged him with being an accessory before the fact. He was sent to the County jail and will be tried with Lindsey on Nov. 5. Bonds were set at \$5,000.
