## Mrs. Eleanor C. Dailey Heads Prominent Group Seeking to Re-elect Roosevelt

With an abiding faith in the present administration, and with a deep determination to have it continue for another four years, there was launched this week, strong organization of public spirited voters of high standing in the professional, business, civic and social life of our group, all formerly Republicans, who are interested in the re-election of President Roosevelt.
