## 'Two Against The World' At Met Saturday

**Humphrey Bogart Of 'Petrified Forest' Fame Takes Leading Part In Film About Radio's 'Peeping Toms'**

A woman pilloried and exposed to public scorn in order to satisfy the greed for gold by appealing to an insatiable appetite for sensational scandal. That is the underlying theme of the First National production, "Two Against the World," which opens at the Metropolitan theatre Saturday, Sunday Monday and Tuesday.

The picture, which reveals the inner workings of a radio network, paints with vivid and startling realism the lengths to which a certain class of grasping, but sanctimonious, executives will go in dragging forth the buried past of individuals for profits. The story depicts a happy home where the shadowy past of twenty years before, in which the wife and mother was the victim of a lurid scandal, was well nigh forgotten in the joys of the present. But on the eve of the wedding of this woman's daughter to the scion of a wealthy society family, a radio corporation saw a chance to increase its profits by blazing this story to the world.

Blasting the lives of the parents, the exposure leaves the innocent daughter to face a hostile public but not alone, for her lover stands by her and together the two seek happiness through their love.

There is a talented cast headed by Humphrey Bogart, noted stage and screen star, who recently made such a hit in "The Petrified Forest" and "Bullets or Ballots" and including Beverly Roberts, Linda Perry, Carlyle Moore, Jr., Henry

O'Neill, Helen MacKellar, Claire Dodd, Hobart Cavanaugh, Paula Stone and Virginia Brissac.

The picture was directed by William McGann from the screen play by Michel Jacoby, dramatized from an idea by Louis Weitzenkorn.

**Clyde Barrie, Baritone, To Broadcast Friday Morning As 'Magazine' Guest Artist**

Clyde Barrie, baritone, called one of the greatest Negro singing discoveries since Roland Hayes, will be a guest singer on the coast to coast program of the "Heinz Magazine of the Air" over Columbia's blue network, October 16th at 11 a. m. (E. S. T.) with a rebroadcast to the west at 3 p. m.

Barrie will be presented on this day in the absence of Reed Kennedy who is the regular soloist on the program heard every Monday, Wednesday and Friday mornings. He will sing Melotte's impressive setting of "The Lord's Prayer."

### Wins Award.

Gifted with a superb voice and a finished and fluent style of singing young Barrie has gained the admiration of veteran artists and gives little hint of difficulties he has conquered in acquiring a musical education.

While studying vocal art he worked as an elevator boy, red cap in a Bufo's station, messenger and file clerk and errand boy. An award

on a radio amateur hour started him on the way to a professional career and he is the first Negro to be signed for a concert series by any radio network.

### Spiritual Authority

Born in Brooklyn, N. Y., Barrie has studied for the past seven years with Mary Ludington, New York vocal teacher. He possesses a wide repertoire of songs ranging from older classics to modern American and European songs and is an authority on Negro spirituals.
