

FORD HAS THE SAME KIND OF FOREIGNERS IN MICHIGAN AS ROCKEFELLER IN COLORADO

We notice that the following preamble of a resolution adopted by the Masons of Colorado is being printed widely in trade journals:

"Whereas, During the past several months there has existed in the coal mining districts of our state a condition of insurrection against the lawful authority of our state government, wherein several thousand misguided and largely unnaturalized men speaking more than twenty different languages, unacquainted with the true principles of constitutional government, consisting in part of veteran soldiers of the recent foreign wars, armed with high-powered rifles, incited, led on and financially sustained by agitators and professional trouble-makers, mostly non-residents of our state, possessing no property or other interests in our commonwealth, have bid open defiance to and made organized war against the lawfully constituted authority of our state, murdered many women and created a reign of terror in the said mining districts and have destroyed hundreds of thousands of dollars worth of property."

But we also notice that, in the state of Michigan, "during the past several months several thousand unnaturalized men, speaking 21 different languages" and employed by a manufacturer named Henry Ford, these several thousand unnaturalized foreigners also being "unacquainted with the true principles of constitutional government" and "possessing no property in the commonwealth" (except their labor)—the same kind of foreigners, we notice, have NOT "armed themselves with high-powered rifles," have NOT "bid open defiance to and made organized war against the lawfully constituted authority of our state" (not even the corner cop), have NOT "created a reign of terror;" in fact, they have been pretty busy working and soaking their \$5-a-day laborer's wages into homes, clothes, good food and other satisfying and enjoyable things.

Is there any need to ask why in Colorado and NOT in Detroit, Mich.?

One answer is that in Colorado these human beings are treated like CATTLE while Ford treats his foreigners like humans.

Rockefeller and his whole crowd of sidelights and defenders in Colorado are making anarchists out of these new immigrants.

In Michigan, Ford is making American citizens out of his.
