SCAB-HIRING AGENCY IS FINED
FOR VIOLATIONS

A keeper of an employment agency was fined \$15 and costs this morning by Judge Courtney for failing to comply with the state law and keep a register of the men he collected fees from.

He is Vincent Pillarsella and has an agency at 1100 S. Halsted. The fine may mean the revocation of his license.

Monday Pillarsella advertised for "Men to do guard duty in Youngstown. Must be six feet tall. Transportation furnished."

State Employment Agency Inspector Richard Knight saw the ad. He went over with some deputies and saw a crowd of 900 men who wanted jobs. Complying with the law, he explained conditions in Youngstown to them. Only 101 men went.

"Chicago should be thankful that these men did take the job," Knight told a Day Book reporter. "Most of them were thugs and plug-uglies who hang out in the Halsted st. pool-rooms. Chicago should say 'good riddance' to such men."

GOING TO GET AFTER OSCAR

Juvenile Protective ass'n special counsel, Harry Smoot, will assist State Factory Inspector Oscar Nelson in prosecution of Oscar Heineman, silk mill man at 2701 Armitage av. Heineman was found giving hundreds of girls who work for him rotten air for their lungs. Each girl is entitled to at least 2,000 cubic feet of air space instead of the 1,400 accorded by Heineman. Nelson found eight one-quart bottles of Bromo Seltzer in the girls' washroom, Heineman explaining that he supplied it for those who got headaches.
