The President has re-nominated Bancroft minister to Berlin. Nicholas Fish, son of the Secretary of State has been nominated assistant secretary of State at the same point.

A Radical newspaper mentions the fact that since the passing of the Ku-Klux bill, not a single case of outrage or violence in the Southern States has been reported. Of course not. The necessity of reporting them has passed.

At the last session of Congress, an act was passed granting pensions to the survivors of the war of 1812. One thousand applications have been made so far.

William Foster, who murdered Mr. Putnam on a New York street car was a pupil at the Jonesville (N.Y.) Academy in 1852. The editor of the Gloverville Standard says he remembers Foster well.

The following letter, in regard to the work on the new State House, written by Hon. R. B. Mason, said to be one of the most skillful civil engineers and practical architects in the Union, is not calculated to elate the capitol-movers:

Dear Sir—I have carefully examined the mason work of the new State House at Springfield, Illinois, and do not see how there could be any very great difference of opinion among those competent to judge in several places quite large holes in the material or workmanship that would, in any way, affect the stability of the building.

Two of the jurors on the Foster murder trial in New York City were opposed to finding him guilty in the first degree, and held out until they were "smoked out" by their ten opponents. The New York Sun tells this story:

All ten fell to smoking. The room was small and badly ventilated. The oppositionists were fat, heavy, short-winded men, so that there could be but one termination to the unequal contest. When they tried to sleep, in order to forget their unpleasant position, they were rudely waked up, and mockingly told that the saving of a man's life depended upon them, and that they should not sleep over it; that if they were to be hung themselves on the morrow they would not be so much inclined to indulge in inactive sleep. Foster's fate was trembling in the balance.

With streaming eyes and heavy hearts, said our informant, "we saw by one of our signatures to the death warrant of William Foster. We did our duty. We recommended him to mercy in the hope, and with the intention that the Governor would extend that clemency to him which our oath prevented us from giving him."

Andy Johnson made a speech at Knoxville lately in which he declared fairly and squarely for repudiation of the national debt. The Republicans and Democrats of Mcville are alike strong in their denunciations of Geo. L. Putnam, recently appointed postmaster of that city by Grant. A strong effort is being made for his removal. Not a single black skin can be found among the executive officers of the new territorial government at Washington.
