ONCE MORE AT WORK—DISCUSSION ON THE SOUTHERN NORMAL SCHOOL. UNIVERSITY AT CARBONDALE.

SPRINGFIELD, Feb. 20.—If, as the truth of history required me to state, yesterday was the dullest of the session, a similar regard for veracity makes it my duty to say that the legislative machine never run more smoothly than to-day.

SOUTHERN ILLINOIS NORMAL UNIVERSITY. The senate spent some time to-day over the bill making an appropriation to erect the Southern Illinois Normal University at Carbondale.
