THE TRIBUNE'S EDITORIAL ON THE CALL SAYS: "The letter of certain New York republicans to Col. Grosvenor, herewith printed, is the first unequivocal response returned to the overture of the liberal republicans of the west for consultation at Cincinnati on May 1. Others will soon follow. There is no longer an excuse for doubt that the convention will be held and be respectably attended. We presume that should any important action be taken at Cincinnati, those present from each state would designate a portion of their number to cast the vote of that state in the convention, but no one is excluded from attending, and the invitation is so broad that many will doubtless be present who have not been invited. Cincinnati professes all a generous welcome. We presume the convention will determine to put forth a declaration of principles, to present national candidates, or adopt some other form of appeal to the east, and to send a delegation to congress. Whatever we do or propose, will necessarily derive all its benefits from accord with public sentiment. This convention speaks with no authority,
