

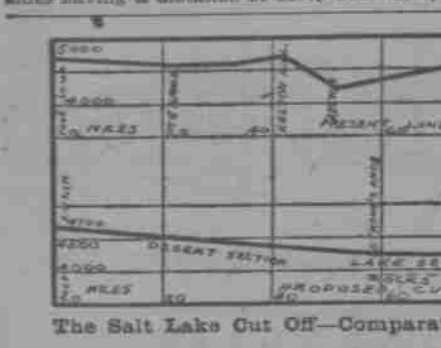
RAILROAD NEWS.

San Francisco, March 25.—Fully 14 miles of the Central Pacific from Ogden west to Lucin and over the Katon and Promontory mountains are to be abandoned and a new road or cut-off of 106 miles built.

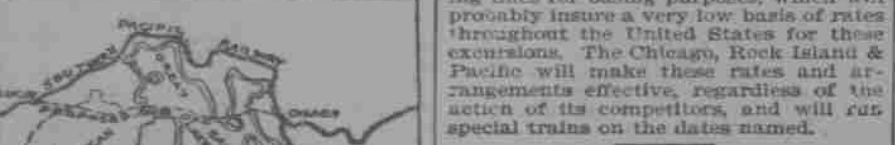

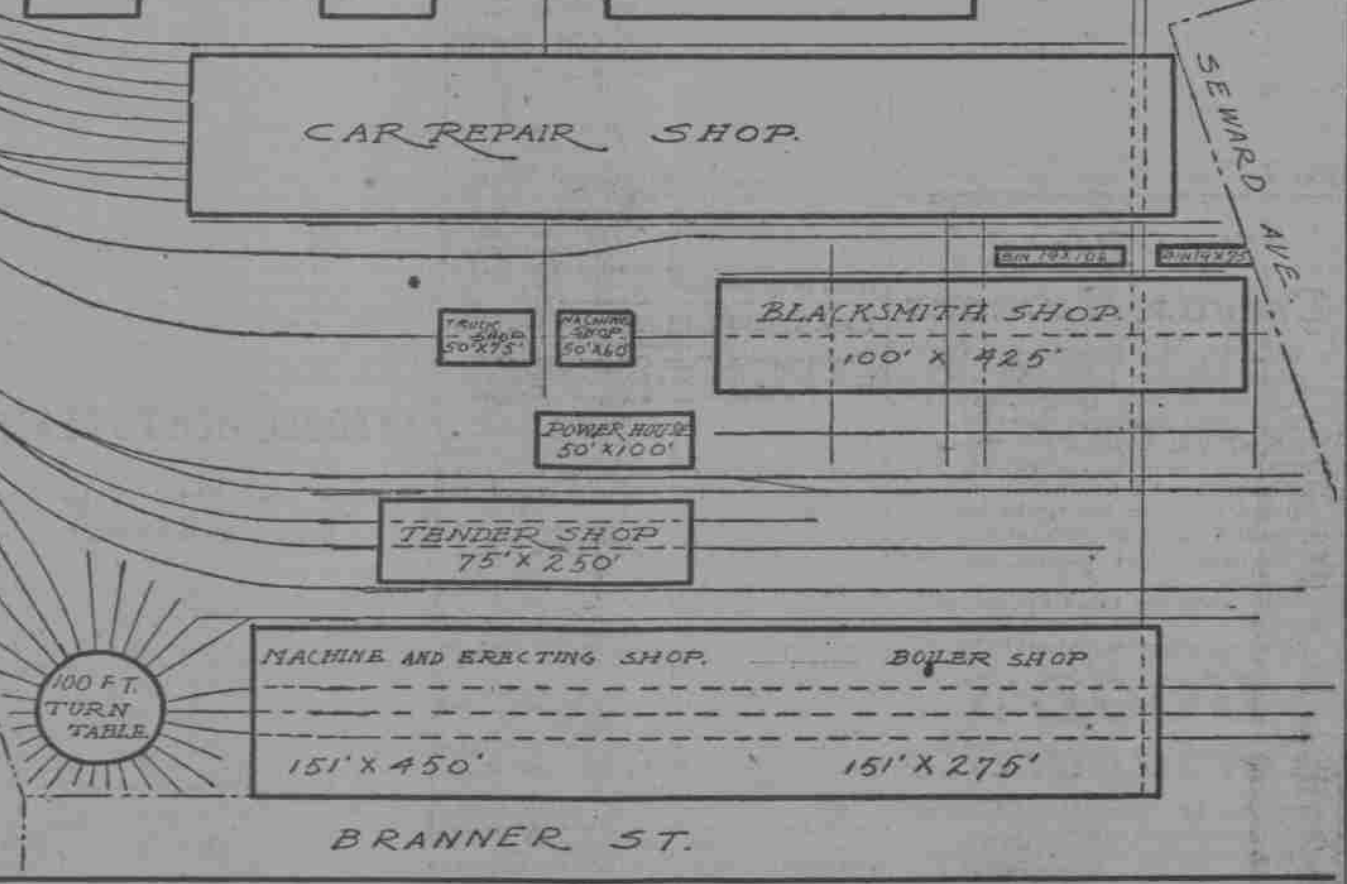
