## NEWS BREVITIES

Baron Reading of Erleigh, Lord Chief Justice who was in Chicago last week on business in connection with loan of the allies, was the guest at a reception given by the Chicago Bar Association.

Mrs. Minnie F. Low has been chosen a member of the new crime committee recently appointed by the judges of Illinois for the purpose of making important changes in the criminal laws of the state.

The Jewish Student Congregation of the University of Michigan at Ann Arbor has been reorganized for the coming season. Congregational singing will be made a feature this year.

As a result of a recent visit of Prof. Horace M. Kallen, of the University of Wisconsin, to St. Louis, Mo., a Menorah society will be formed by the Jewish students of Washington University.

Three Jews were successful at the primary elections held in Boston, Mass., last week for nominations to the Legislature. They are Simon Swig, who formerly represented the city of Taunton in the Legislature; David Mancowitz, who has long represented Ward 8, and Samuel Silverman, a newcomer in politics.

Dr. Meltzer, of the Rockefeller Institute for Medical Research, heads a movement (the International Medical Brotherhood), the object of which is to improve the social relations existing among medical men all over the world.

The five weeks' campaign of the two B'nai B'rith Lodges of St. Louis, Mo., resulted in securing a list of 1065 candidates. The campaign demonstrates the prediction that there were in the St. Louis Jewish community three thousand unaffiliated Jews who were able and willing to assume the responsibilities and duties of B'nai B'rith membership. The applicants include men from all walks of life; the merchant prince, the artisan, the lawyer, the doctor, the mechanic, and the clerk.

The Russian Ministry has instructed the governors near the war zone to ask all Jews to hold themselves in readiness to evacuate their homes at short notice.
