IN LAWRENCE CIRCUIT COURT

W. A. Holder alleges that he obtained a judgment in the Green county circuit court against F. A. Chidester for \$1,700; to defeat the collection of this judgment the plaintiff claims in his petition that defendant Chidester sold lot 2 block 1 and lots 1 and 4 in block 2 in Gammill's 2d add to Marionville to one William Houston; plaintiff therefore wants the court to divest title of said real estate of Houston and vest same in plaintiff.

Corliss Crandal filed replevin suit against Emmett Merrick for the possession of a certain bay horse of the value of \$100, which plaintiff alleges he purchased from Lark Merrick, father of the defendant.

February 4, 1913 Prosecuting Attorney Miller filed an information against Edgar Zinn and Vesker Zinn charging that they did upon that date make a felonious assault upon Henry Horstman. On February 5th defendants were arrested by Sheriff Cherry and afterwards released on bonds in the sum of \$500 each.
