Coroner's Jury Exonerates Negro That Caused Death of a White Man.

Nelson Holden, the negro cool-wagon driver who fatally shot Dennis Haley, a St. Louisan, Saturday afternoon, was exonerated by a coroner's jury at the inquest yesterday afternoon. A verdict of justifiable homicide was returned and the authorities were requested to release Holden.

Holden's testimony was impressive. He said that Haley, Charles Dittmer and Rudolph Araberger, the three white men, had followed him for ten blocks and finally assaulted him in the alley, and that Haley began firing and had fired three shots before he could get to his revolver.
