THE TRAIN DISPATCHER.

He Must Know a Great Many Things and Do Them Well. The position of a train dispatcher is a very responsible one.

He must know all the grades, curves, capacity of side-tracks and location of all telegraph offices on his division; must know the hauling capacity of all locomotives running on his division.

As each train arrives and leaves a station the operator reports it by using the signal os os, which attracts the dispatcher's attention and he carries the time on a sheet called a train sheet.

It requires the greatest watchfulness and care on the part of the dispatcher to keep the trains moving and from trying to "pass on a single track."
