Taken in all its aspects and viewed from every point, the repulse of the British at the battle of New Orleans on the eighth of January, 1815, was the most important event in American history...

Next Tuesday the anniversary of the battle of New Orleans will be celebrated, and in view of this circumstance the following sketch of the affair is given.

GENERAL JACKSON'S ARRIVAL

Along the main highway leading from Fort St. John, six miles from New Orleans, a party of gentlemen rode, on the morning of December 2, 1814, at a brisk trot. The air was foggy and chilly and damp.

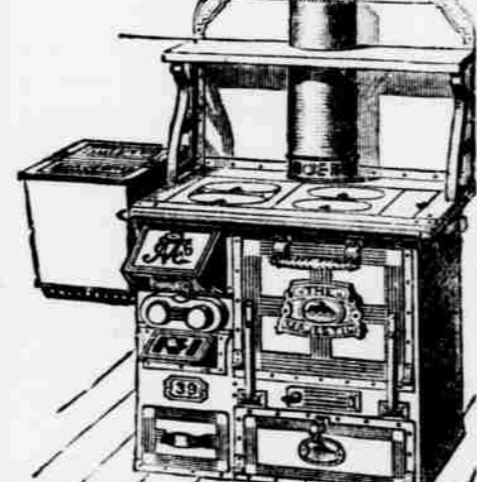
