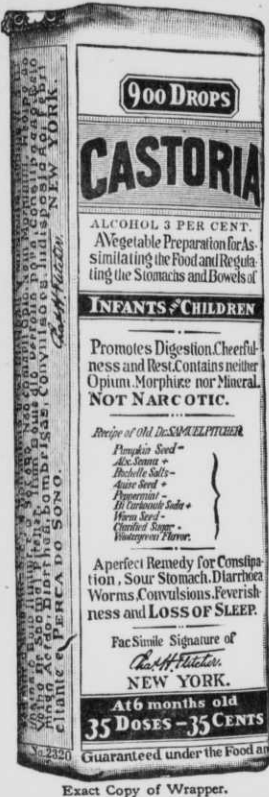

ATLANTIC WATERWAYS ASSOCIATION PLANNING GIGANTIC UNDERTAKING

ances have been received from hundreds of prominent men who will take part in the deliberations. Ten thousand dollars will be spent in entertaining the visitors. It is declared that an inland waterway has become an imperative necessity and would be invaluable to the government in time of war.

OPEN GREAT TUNNEL AT PORT HURON TODAY

Port Huron, Mich., November 12.—Distinguished railroad officials and electrical experts of the United States and Canada were guests of the Grand Trunk railroad today at the formal inaugural of the electrified international tunnel between this city and Sarnia, Ont. The electrification of the tunnel was one of the largest electrical railroad contracts ever carried out in America.

have been built for the work. They have among the largest of their kind in the world, have a tractive power of 30 per cent. greater than the steam locomotive and can haul trains at an average speed of 10 miles an hour over the heavy tunnel grades. The new system also insures safety, which is more important than efficiency or speed, as the St. Clair tunnel since its completion in 1891 has gained an unenviable notoriety by the number of fatal accidents which have occurred in it. The least accident to a train passing through by steam power meant that some of the crew would be asphyxiated by the coal gases and many employees have been killed in this way. It was necessary to pass through the tunnel that every car should be sealed as nearly as hermetically as possible and the result was by no means a comfortable one for either crew or passengers under the most favorable conditions.

Under the electric system the interior of the tunnel has been brilliantly illuminated with arc lights and painted white. The absence of coal

fumes and the ventilation make the air in the tunnel now so pure that the car windows can be left open during the entire run.

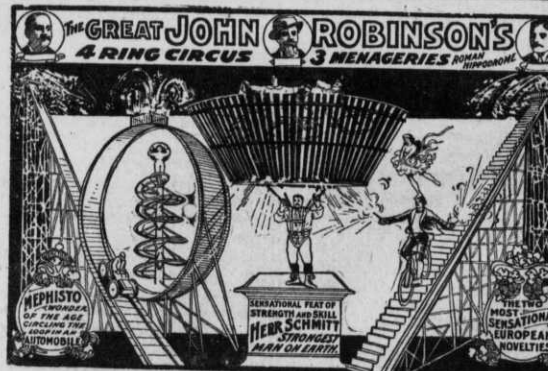
