DEAR ALEX.—Don't you think you have been very remiss in your duties as a journalist in not correcting the errors of the editor of the Yazoo City Herald?

The principal industry of the city is the Old Mill, which Maj. Charles Mann is superintendent. It belongs to the American Oil Trust, a company now owning four-fifths of the oil fields of the country.

There are two banking establishments: the Bank of Yazoo City, established in 1878 by C. O. Shepherd, and the Yazoo City Bank, established in 1880 by J. S. Shannon.

The county buildings, court house and jail, are among the best in the State. The city is of high order of civilization, and the people are generally well educated.

The free public school system in operation with about 150 schools in the county. The public schools of Yazoo City are in the front rank of the best in the State.

Yazoo City is one of the most compactly built places in the South. It is located on a V shaped point, a high bluff overlooking the river on the other, with country immediately above liable to overflow.

Yazoo has a careful and economical city government. The assessed value is \$1,700,000, which is one of the highest in the State.
