Department of the Interior, General Land Office, August 7, 1900.

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids directed to the Commissioner of the General Land Office, will be received by the Receiver of the U. S. Land Office at Helena, Montana, up to and including the 24th day of January, 1901, for the purchase, under the provisions of the act of June 4, 1897 (30 Stats. 34-36) of 500,000 feet of matured living pine, spruce, fir and balsam timber, 14 inches and upwards in diameter, with the wood to be cut from the tops and lops of the living timber and the dead timber sound enough for fuel; all to be cut and taken from unsurveyed lands within the limits of the Flathead Forest Reserve, Montana, approximately in Secs. 32, 33 & 34, T. 35 N., R. 17 W., and lying along the eastern shore of Stark Lake, about four miles from Altyn Post-office, Montana. No bid of less than \$1.00 per thousand feet for timber and \$2.25 per cord for wood will be considered. All dead timber on the tract sufficiently sound for fuel, must be cut and removed, and the brush and rubbish must be piled for burning under the supervision of the forest officer supervising the cutting and removal, and the felling, cutting and removal of the timber must be conducted with the necessary care to preserve the timber left remaining on the land from injury. A deposit of \$200.00 with the Receiver will be required with each bid and payment in full of the value of all said timber and the sum of \$50.00 additional, the approximate value of the wood involved, a total sum of \$550.00, must be made within 30 days of notice of award, or may, at the option of the purchaser, be made in equal installments within 30, 60 and 90 days, respectively, on the date of such notice. The living timber to be cut, will be marked and designated by the officer under whose supervision the cutting will be done, and no part of it will be cut until so marked and designated, and no timber will be removed until it has been measured by the officer in charge, and paid for, in compliance with the terms of this notice. Purchasers failing to remove all said timber within one year from date of notice of award, forfeit both purchase money and right to timber unremoved, unless an extension of is granted. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved.

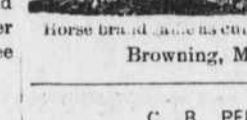

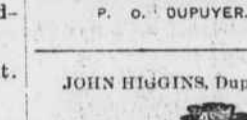
