

WAS A BUSY MONTH

Reports of the Various City Officers for the Thirty Days of June.

THERE WERE 304 ARRESTS

Remarks of the Chief of Police, the Sanitary Policeman, the Health Officer and the Chief of the Fire Department.

Butte, July 2.—The report of Chief of Police Tebo for June shows that there were 304 arrests made during the month, of which 284 were males and 20 females. There were 272 convictions secured and 22 dismissals. The arrests were made on the following charges: Intoxication 47, Disturbing the peace 59, Petit larceny 25, Vagrancy 116, House of ill-fame 9, Fast driving 1, Assault and battery 17, Having stolen goods 2, Forgery 1, Horse stealing 2, Abusive language 2, Attempt to break jail 4, Doing business without license 3, Attempt to murder 1, Attempted bank robbery 1, Interfering with an officer 1, Malicious mischief 1, Passing liquor to prisoners in jail 1, Carrying concealed weapons 2, The mortuary report of Dr. E. D. Evans, acting city physician, shows that there were 28 deaths last month as compared with 53 for June of last year. The causes of death were as follows: Railroad accident 3, Other accident 1, Bronchitis 2, Burns 2, Cancer of liver 1, Enteritis 1, Cerebral hemorrhage 2, Hemorrhage of stomach and bowels 1, Uterine hemorrhage 1, Nephritis 1, Pneumonia 5, Peritonitis 1, Premature and still births 3, Whooping cough 1, Weakness 1, Unknown 1. The fatalities were as follows: Montana, 11; other states, 2; Austria, 1; Russia, 1; not stated, 4. Eleven were married and the others were all single. All were white. The ages were as follows: Under 1 year, 6; 1 to 5, 2; 5 to 10, 7; 10 to 15, 4; 15 to 20, 1; 20 to 30, 1; 30 to 40, 1; 40 to 50, 1; 50 to 60, 1; 60 to 70, 1; 70 to 80, 1; 80 to 90, 1; 90 to 100, 1.

To Close Them Up. Denver, July 2.—State Insurance Commissioner Walpole has requested the attorney general to take all necessary steps to prevent the Great Western Mutual Aid association and the Great Western Mutual Accident association continuing business. A. H. Northrup, who had charge of the business of both companies, has been appointed receiver for them by the court on application of Fred Steinhauer, who says that since July 28, 1881, he has advanced \$38,000 to pay losses and expenses, none of which were paid back. Steinhauer says that for years the companies have been carrying on business at a loss, and they have no assets of value. These companies have done but little business in Denver for some years, but have found a field in the interior towns and in other states.

Iron Mills Sold.

Pittsburg, July 2.—The iron mills of Moorehead, McLean company, have been sold by the sheriff. The plant is worth over \$1,000,000, but went for \$11,000, just enough to cover taxes due and sheriff's costs. The purchaser is the New York Life Insurance company, the holder of a mortgage for \$350,000. The interest accumulated ran up to \$370,000. The creditors of the Moorehead, McLean company has granted the company an extension and taken as security a blanket mortgage on the mill property for \$600,000. They are left without security and nothing to fall back on.
