MOURNERS WALK IN SLUSH

Have No Alternative in Chicago Because of Livery Strike. COLORADO SITUATION IS IMPROVING. Master Plumbers of Cincinnati Will See Unions on Three Different Counts—Bazon Workmen Denied Christmas.

The Keefe residence was surrounded at the time of the funeral by pickets. The police were present, holding themselves in readiness in case of violence, but none was encountered.

A more serious phase of the strike developed today in the threatened spread of the toup to include stablemen and stockmen. Should these men go out the ambulance service of the city would be seriously crippled.

May Get Solid Hearings. Permission to remove sick from their homes to hospitals was granted in several instances by striking livery drivers.

An undertaker's wagon in lieu of a hearse was secured to convey the remains of Judge Jonas Hutchinson of the superior court from his residence to Oakwood cemetery.

A "dead" wagon, driven by a son of Undertaker Ferrigo, returning from Grace-land cemetery after a burial, was pursued through down town streets by a coal wagon, whose union driver attempted to ram the undertaker's van with the pole of his wagon.

Strikes are practically over. There are 100 miners working in Cripple Creek, and the Tebular mine, one after another, are being reopened.

Orders have been issued to reduce the Cripple Creek force immediately from 375 to 200 men and to relieve 115 men at Telluride, thus cutting the force in that district to 125 men.

Governor Peabody has offered a reward of \$50 for the arrest and conviction of the dynamiter who wrecked five miners' homes at Newcastle on December 17.

The Denver Citizens' alliance today offered \$100 reward for the apprehension of the New Castle dynamiter.

TELLURIDE, Colo., Dec. 19.—Suits were filed today against Sheriff J. C. Rutan and his bondsmen by Guy E. Miller, president of the miners' union.

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WASHINGTON, Dec. 19.—What seems to be an attempt on the part of the Chicago hotel managers to raise rates during the national republican convention is to be stopped in the bud by the national republican committee.

CLEVELAND, Dec. 19.—According to an official statement made by the Central Trust company this afternoon, it has been found that E. W. Rader, late secretary and treasurer of the concern, was short in his accounts at least \$20,000 at the time of his death on August 25 last.

MUD ENGLUFS OCTOGENARIAN. Inmate of Odd Fellows' Home at Unlappert Strays onto Treacherous Slimes.

NEW YORK, Dec. 19.—William Becker, 86 years old, an inmate of the Odd Fellows' home at Unlappert, has met his death through a fall into a vat of molasses.
