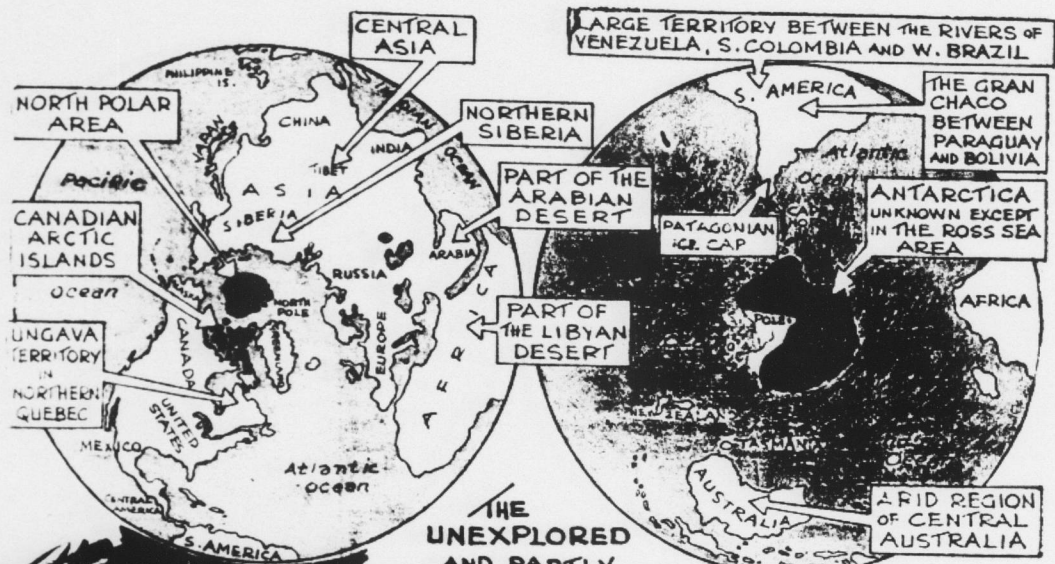
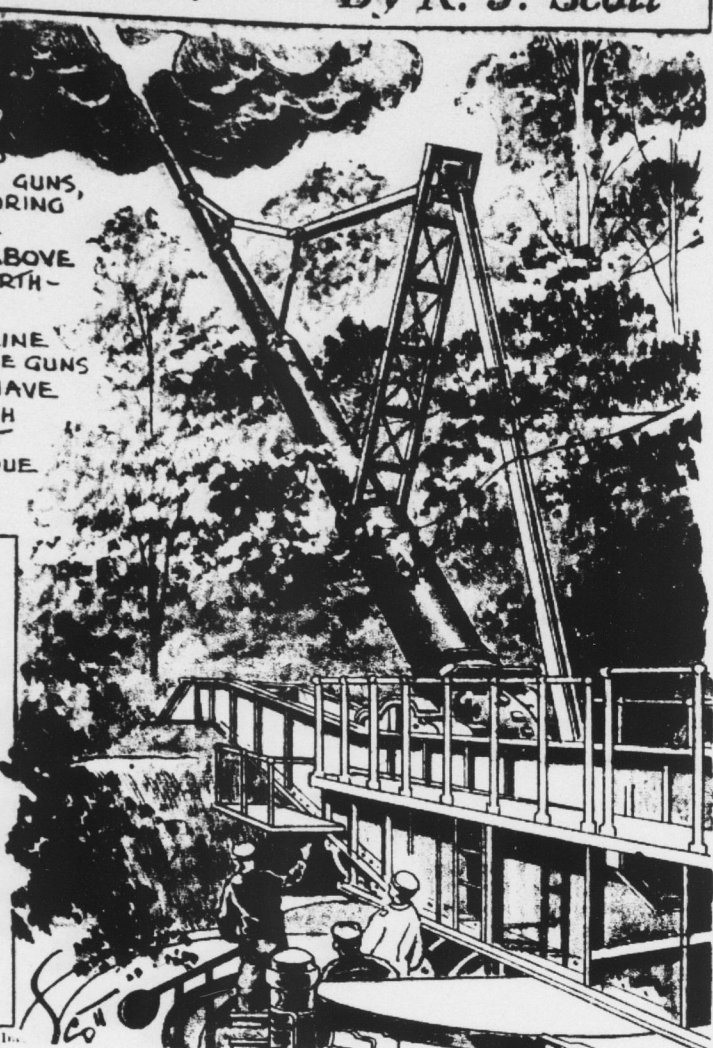


DID YOU KNOW? - - - By R. J. Scott

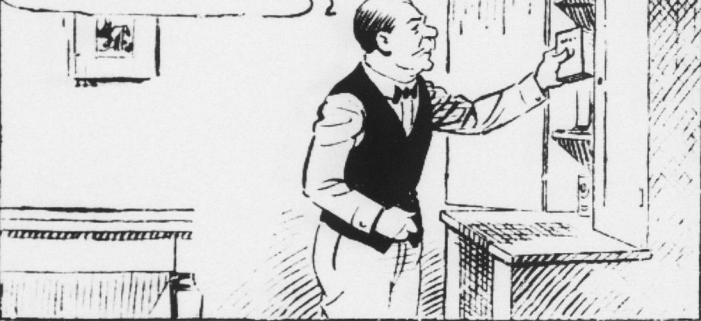

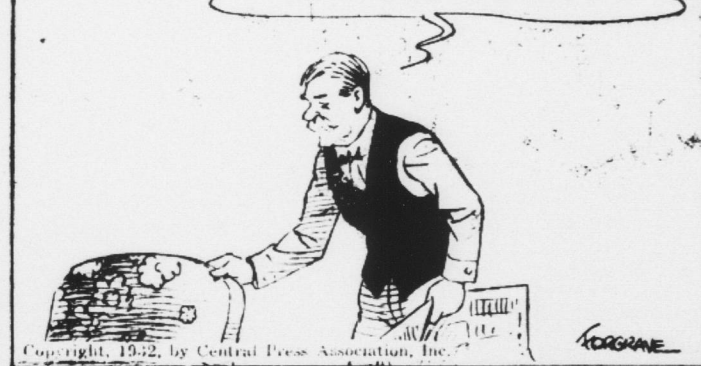
