Does Sorghum Exhaust the Soil?

Not, Says Mr. French, if It Is Fed on the Farm and Returned to the Land in the Form of Manure.

Several letters have come recently asking in substance if sorghum is not a very hard crop on land? We believe this depends very largely upon what use is made of the sorghum crop when harvested.

A forage plant that will produce from three to seven tons of cured hay per acre, and does not belong to the nitrogen gathering crop, must secure its food from the soil on which it grows and that in large quantities. It naturally follows then as we have said above that were we to sell this large amount of rough food off our farms we would deplete the fertility of the land very materially.
