Many Practical Uses

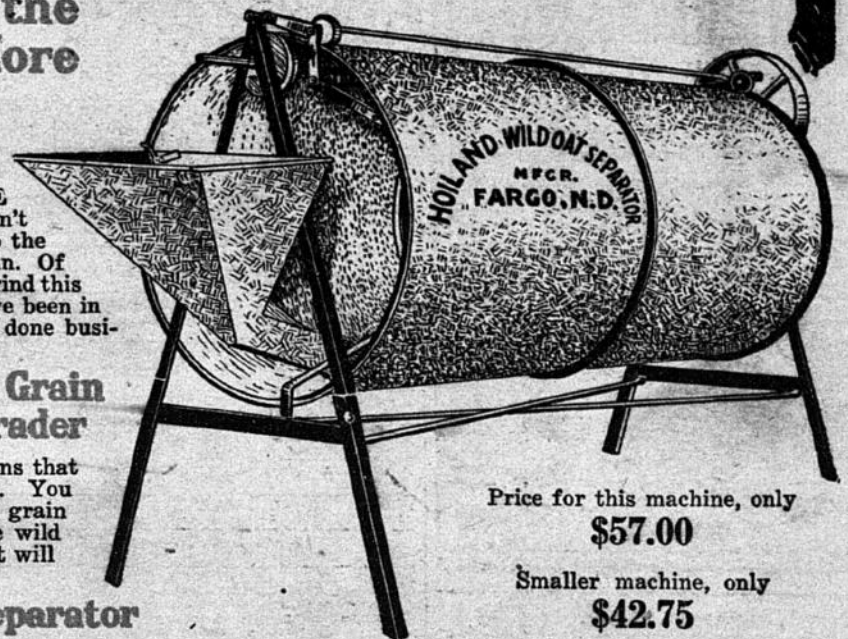
