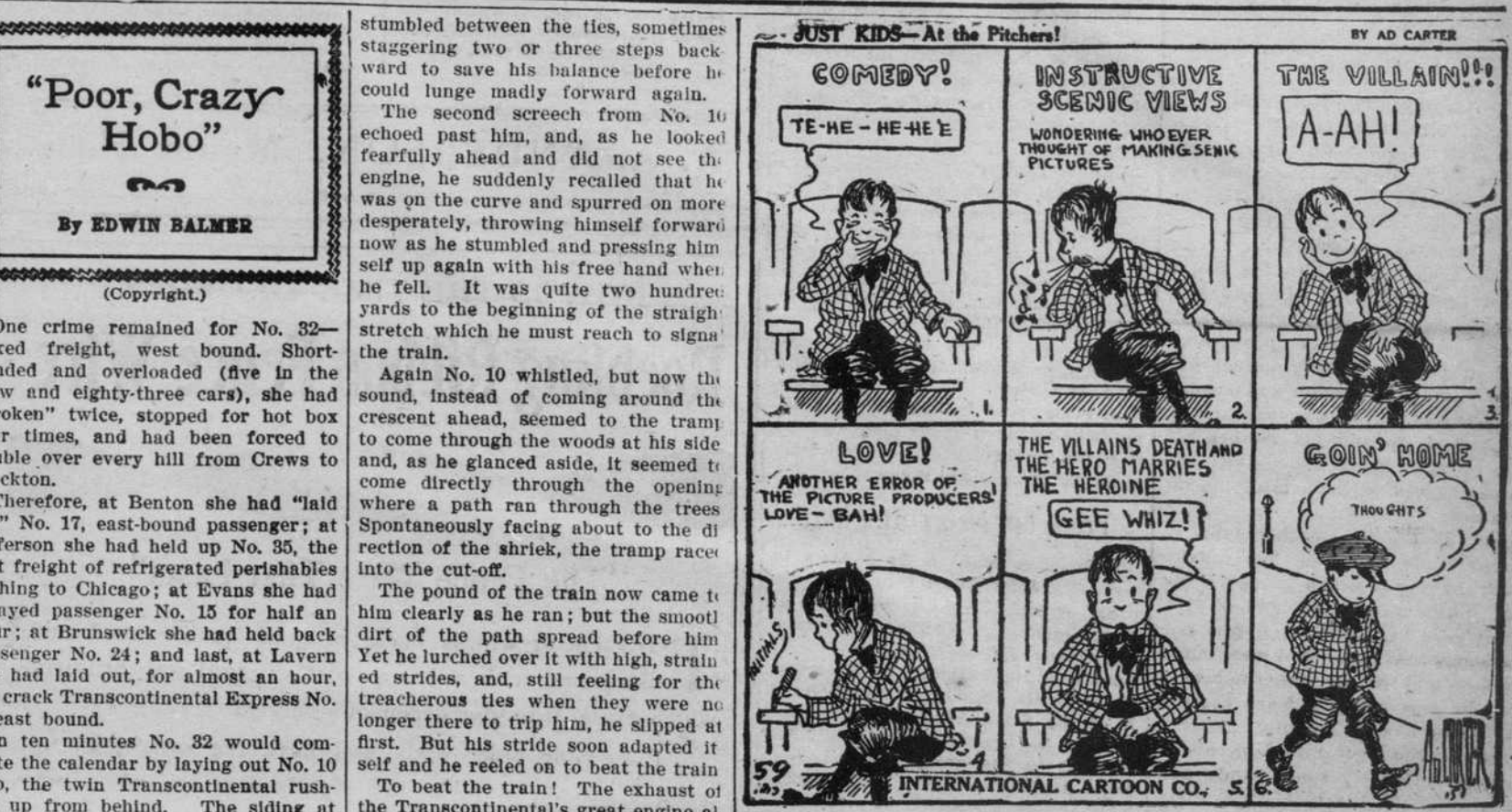
The crew had found it best to sleep in the caboose at the end of the train till the volume of the snoring through the windows told that the tramps had departed.
