Big Purchases Are Feature of Day's Session

Buying for Both Accounts is Witnessed During an Active and Broad Market; Canadian Pacific Is Leader.

BY MORNING JOURNAL SPECIAL LEADER. New York, Aug. 24.—Buying for both accounts, including extensive covering of short contracts, was witnessed in today's broad and active stock market, some leaders registering maximum quotations of the year.

Foremost feature of the two-hour session, in which the turnover was \$25,000,000, were Canadian Pacific, which made an extreme gain of eight points, retaining all but the smallest fraction, and United States Steel's gain of 2 1/2 points to 114 1/2, its top price of the year.

Numerous other rails, industrials and sundry specialties were lifted one to two points, the rise being gradual and sustained throughout. Few isolated losses were noted. Final prices showed no impairment.

Bonds moved upward, though moderately, foreign issues participating especially in the French group and United Kingdom, which again touched par. Total sales of bonds, par value, aggregated \$5,575,000.

A gain of almost \$30,000,000 in actual excess reserves was the most notable feature of the weekly bank statement, showing another marked contraction.
