Finally Pass the Postoffice Appropriation Bill.

And Consider and Act upon a Number of Important Public Matters.

SENATE.

A Heated Political Discussion caused by the Postoffice Bill.

WASHINGTON, May 4.—After the passage of a number of private bills the postoffice appropriation bill was laid before the senate.

Mr. Call favored the proposal to appropriate \$300,000 for the carriage of the United States mails to Central and South America, Japan, China, etc. He did not regard it as a subsidy. Sausbury opposed the proposition. Hale said according to Beck's explanation given yesterday the postoffice department was more culpable than he at first supposed, as to the leaving at Pernambuco of a large body of Rio de Janeiro mails. From Beck's explanation, Hale said it would seem that the postmaster general had sent mails by an English steamer, while knowing they would have to lie over at Pernambuco, a long way from their destination, and would have to wait for the coming of the United States steamer for Brazil. Hale could see no stronger illustration of the preference of the postmaster general for foreign over American ships since he had sent mails part of the way by foreign ships.

Plumb said no senator had shown that the sum per mile provided by the amendment was too much. The proposed arrangement for foreign mails was based on the theory that it was a subsidy, but that we should apply to our foreign mails the principle that had for many years been applied to the transportation of inland mails of the United States.

Mr. Plumb asked how we were to be benefited by the proposed arrangement.

THE SOUTHERN STATES WOULD BE BENEFICIARIES of this proposition; yet senators from the southern states were opposing this proposition. They did not speak the language of modern progress on modern civilization. The south today was the south of Calhoun, of Yancey, and of Jefferson Davis.

Morgan interrupted him to comment on the unfairness of this class of argument at this late stage of the debate. The southern men, he said, had no opportunity to reply to it.

Plumb said no senator should be cut off from reply by limitation of time; at least his vote would be cast for a full opportunity to reply. The south today, in national control, he continued, responded to the wishes, interests and principles inculcated by Calhoun, enforced by Yancey, and represented today by Jefferson Davis. He (Plumb) did not speak of that as in any sense to be personally, offensively, or as qualifying the personal sincerity of any man.

Morgan remarked that no such imputation or accusation had the slightest offense for him. Every name mentioned by Plumb was consecrated in Morgan's memory as the name of an

HONORABLE AND GREAT MAN. He hoped the state of Kansas might some time or other produce such characters as Calhoun, Yancey or Davis. Plumb retorted that Morgan had that aspiration for Kansas all to himself. Plumb would not take one leaf from the chaplet of any man as an honorable, sincere, or able man, but those men represented the south of slavery; the south that did not want free labor; so the south took up today the burden of that song where it left off in '61. It was an old doctrine in favor of capital against labor. The capitalist with his coffers filled and believing in the law of supply and demand as applied to labor, like everything else, said, "give me right to buy my ships where I please, where I can buy cheaply products of labor of other countries and I don't care about American labor."

After considerable further discussion a vote was taken on the final passage of the bill as follows: yeas, 45; nays, 10.

IN FAVOR OF UNITED STATES SUPREMACY Morgan, offered a series of resolutions which were ordered printed and to lie on the table, declaring it is the duty of congress to extend necessary mail facilities across the seas from the principal ports of all foreign countries with which the United States has any considerable trade or where the trade can be profitably developed; that it is the duty of congress to provide that American people shall have the right to buy ships abroad and import them at reasonable rates of duty, and the laws prohibiting the importation of foreign built ships are as unjust and unwise as laws would be that would prohibit importation of all other articles of foreign manufacture. The senate then adjourned.

HOUSE. THE CHINESE. WASHINGTON, May 4.—The house committee on foreign affairs today decided to call up in turn the Chinese in demerit bill and Morrow's Chinese restriction bill when the committee is next called by the speaker.

AFTER THE MORMONS. Hearing on the Mormon question was resumed by the sub-committee of the house committee on judiciary today. Miss Kate Field and a number of other ladies were present. West, a member of the Utah legislature, and Delegate Caine made addresses opposing the Edmunds bill.

GIVING WHISKY A SHOW. The house committee on ways and means will report favorably on the bill to amend laws relating to the entry of distilled spirits in distillery or in any special bonded warehouse, and the withdrawal of same therefrom and the payment of tax thereon. The essential feature of the bill, as explained by its author, is that it will allow distilled spirits to remain in warehouses without payment of tax as long as the owner desires instead of payment being made compulsory at the expiration of three years as now provided by law. A favorable report was also ordered on the bill introduced by Morrison to repeal all provisions of law which give commissions to collectors of internal revenue on taxes collected by them upon distilled spirits.
