

CARRIE NATION'S BODY IS TAKEN TO RICHMOND FOR BURIAL

Famous Kansas Saloon Smasher Who Created Greatest Temperance Wave in State Dies in Private Sanitarium.

SHE WAS TERROR OF SUNFLOWER JOINTISTS

Body of Mrs. Carrie Nation, who died in a private sanitarium in Richmond, Va., was taken today to Kansas City, Kan., by Mrs. M. D. Moore...

It became evident several days ago that Mrs. Nation could not recover and Dr. Al Samalaky, a physician at the sanitarium, informed her that she was near death...

Worried over lawsuits, which she had filed against a lecture bureau for alleged failure to pay for services on the platform, it is said to have caused her to break down.

A recent attempt to serve her with summons in a suit was halted by the sheriff of the sanitarium.

The first few months of Mrs. Nation's life in the sanitarium was in marked contrast to her former activities. She was seen smoking a cigarette...

Mrs. Carrie Nation was born in Kentucky in 1845. Her maiden name was Carrie Moore, and as a girl it is said she was absolutely fearless.

In her early life she married a man who was addicted to the use of intoxicants which resulted in her intense aversion to the saloon.

Later she moved to Kansas and married David Nation, who sympathized with her temperance principles. He divorced her ten years ago.

Mrs. Nation's first saloon smashing was done in the barroom of the Carl hotel at Wichita, December 17, 1890. She was arrested and remained in jail several days before she was released on bond.

On January 31, 1891, armed with her favorite weapon, a bar stool, Mrs. Nation made another raid on Wichita. This time she smashed two saloons.

During the next three months Mrs. Nation surprised the jointists in various Kansas towns, appearing unharmed and leaving a trail of ruined barroom fixtures wherever she went.

Many jointists became terror-stricken when the militant temperance advocate appeared in their neighborhood and locked their places and fled before the faithful habitué could get in an order.

Remarkably few of the saloonmen used violence in resisting Mrs. Nation although she was assaulted and badly hurt while wrecking a barroom at Emporia, Kan.
