Seeks to Divorce Manicure Who Demands \$100,000 Heart Balm From Millionaire.

meyer for \$100,000 for alleged breach of promise to marry, was served yesterday with papers in a divorce suit brought against her by Garry Hearn, who claims he married her in Rochester, N. Y., June 1, 1908. The suit is being brought in Schenectady County. Miss Hearn, in the office of her attorneys, Rosenthal & Halperin of No. 147 1/2 Broadway, denied again yesterday that she was ever married to Garry Hearn, said to be a hotel man-

ager in Schenectady, and also denied the charges of misconduct included in Hearn's complaint.

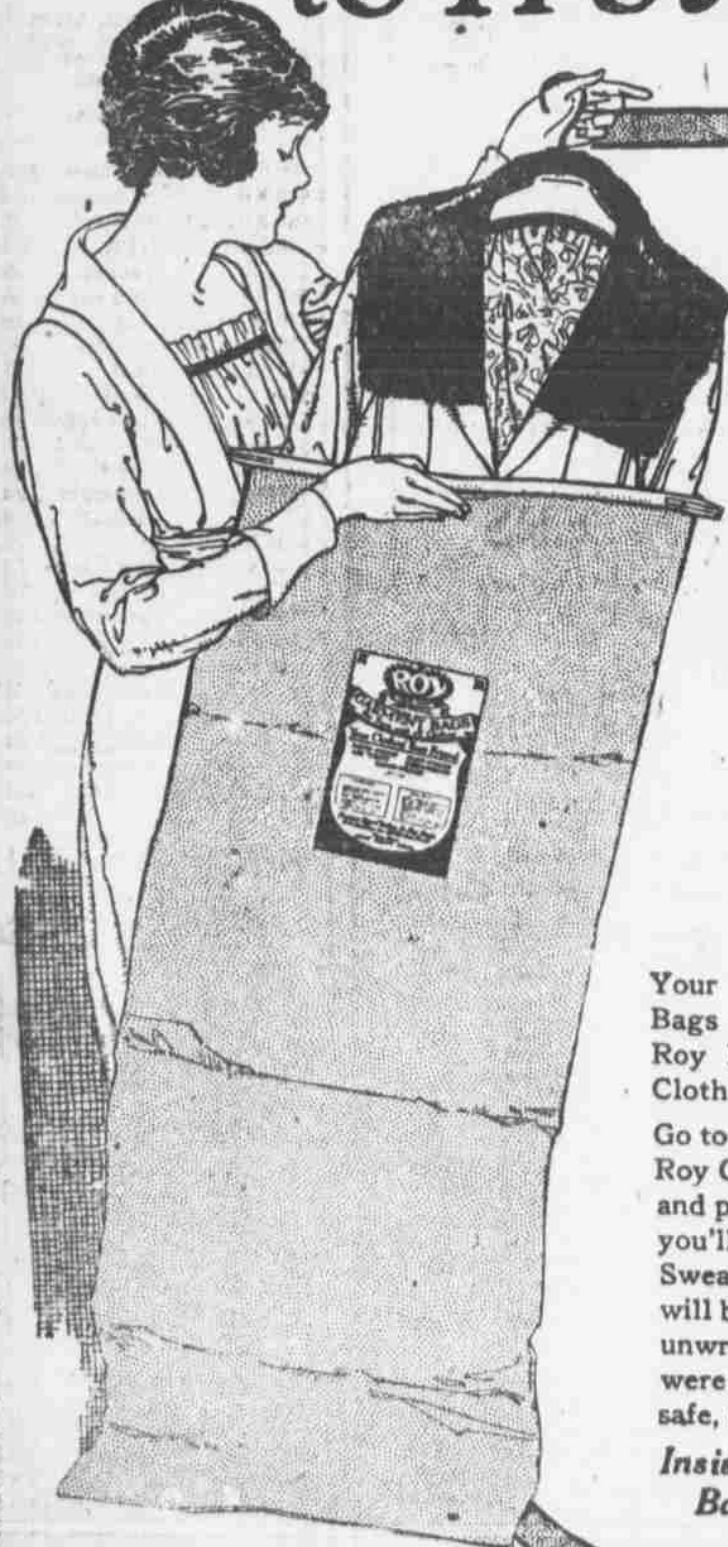
