Counsel for Citizens Union Asails \$1,190,500 Contract for Preliminary Work.

BLOW TO HOUSING PLANS

Estimate Board Accepts Only Bid Despite La Guardia and Curran's Protests.

The contract for the foundation and rough plumbing of the new court house for New York county was awarded yesterday by the Board of Estimate to Rodgers & Haggerty, the only bidder, at \$1,190,500, the Republican members voting against the award and declaring the figure exorbitant.

WANTED IN QUAKER CITY

More Indictments Due Soon For Using the Mails for Fraudulent Purposes.

Twelve of the fifty individuals indicted with oil companies and brokerage houses on charges of using the mails to promote oil stock frauds had been arrested last night in the United States District Court, and one, Lewis C. Van Riper, after furnishing \$30,000 bail, was released as a fugitive from justice, wanted in Philadelphia.
