1,525 PASSENGERS**

British Diplomat Interested
in Irish Women Pickets
at Dock.

EXPERIENCE NO TROUBLE

English Cricketers Arrive for
Series of Matches with
American Teams.

Delayed eight hours in docking because of the difficulties in getting the Aquitania out of her berth, the Cunarder Mauretania reached her pier last night with 1,525 passengers from Southampton. The line had enough longshoremen on hand to take care of the passengers' baggage as smoothly as if there had been no trouble on the Chelsea piers all day.

Prominent among the arrivals was the Hon. Ronald C. Lindsay, Charge d'Affaires at the British Embassy in Washington. He was greatly amused to observe the picketing Irish women at the pier and hoped they would not mistake him for a more important British official, as he said they had once mistaken Edmond De Valera himself. He said he had come here after a leave of absence only to clear up his affairs at

Washington, as he has been promoted to the higher post of Counsellor to the British Embassy at Paris.
H. L. Peters, managing director of Lipton, Ltd., arrived on the first leg of a round the world journey given him as a vacation by Sir Thomas Lipton. His wife and daughter accompanied him. Another journeyer around the world was Miss Estred Ansen Ott, twenty-year-old Girl Scout from Denmark, who is being sent on the trip by a Danish newspaper, for which she is writing her experiences. Arriving to rejoin and marry her sweetheart was Miss Rosa Frolk of Prague, Czechoslovakia. Her fiancé, Major Jira Stehlik, assistant military attaché to the Czechoslovak Legation at Washington, was at the pier to meet her. They had not seen each other in six years, she having been busy with her war work and the Major having been engaged successively during the war with the French army, the Polish, and then the troops of his own Czechoslovakia. Thirteen members of a British cricket team arrived to play matches with the various cricket clubs in this country. They were met at the pier by Sidney Young, a prominent Philadelphia sportsman, whose guests they will be for a time. They were escorted to a special car he had reserved for them over the Pennsylvania Railroad, and they went directly to Philadelphia.
George Arliss, the actor, returned, with Mrs. Arliss. He said he is to appear soon in a new play the name of which has not been selected. Laurence Leonard, well known British barytone, arrived to sing under a three year contract with Mrs. Antonia Sawyer. Mme. Novello Davies, mother of Ivor Novello, composer of the music to "Keep the Home Fires Burning," and other popular ballads, was another arrival. James E. West, Chief Scout executive of the Boy Scouts of America, and Col. H. Livingston of the same organization, returned after witnessing the "International Jamboree" of Boy Scout organizations, held recently in England.
