## DISTRICT COURT SUMMONS.

IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF THE STATE of Nevada, in and for the county of Elko.

THE STATE OF NEVADA SENDS GREETING TO NORMAN WINES:

You are hereby notified to appear in an action commenced against you by Naomi Wines as plaintiff in the District Court of the State of Nevada in and for the county of Elko, State of Nevada, at the town of Elko and answer the complaint therein which is on file with the Clerk of said Court within ten days after the service on you of this summons (exclusive of the day of same,) if served in said county, or twenty days if served out of said county, but within this District, and in all other cases forty days, or judgment by default will be taken against you according to the prayer of said complaint. The said action is brought to recover judgment against you the said defendant, dissolving the bonds of Marriage now existing between you and plaintiff and granting to the plaintiff a divorce and also that the custody and control of the two minor children, Marion Naomi Wines and James Ira Wines be awarded to plaintiff and also that the plaintiff be decreed permanent alimony and setting aside to her as such alimony the W 1/2 of the S E 1/4 of Section 2, and the N E 1/4 of the N E 1/4 of Section 11, and Lot 3 of the N W 1/4 of Section 12, and the S E 1/4 of the S E 1/4 of Section 2, all being in Township No 29 North, Range 68, East, Mount Diablo Base and meridian in Elko county, State of Nevada. Said application is made by the plaintiff upon the grounds of willful desertion and failure to provide the common necessities of life for plaintiff for the space of one year before the commencement of this action, all of which will fully appear from the complaint on file herein. And you are hereby notified that if you fail to appear and answer the said complaint as above required the said plaintiff will apply to the Court for the relief demanded in the complaint and in this summons.
