Council Will Meet Again This Week.

So Democratic Members May Attend Convention.

Council was in session Monday evening only long enough to recess again until Friday evening. It was the intention to pass the payroll ordinance which has been held up a couple of months, owing to lack of funds, but Treasurer Berger stated that he will not be ready to pay out until Saturday. In view of this, Council recessed until Friday evening, when the payroll will be passed, and on Saturday the delayed pay of the city employes and creditors of the city will be distributed.

At the meeting Friday evening, much of the regular business which would ordinarily come before the Council at its first meeting in September will be taken up. There are two things which would make it inconvenient to hold a Council meeting the first of next week, Monday is Labor day, and the Democratic State convention will be held on the 1st and 2nd of September. Nearly all the Democratic members of Council expect to attend the convention, and for these reasons some of the regular business booked for disposal at the first meeting in September will be handled Friday evening.

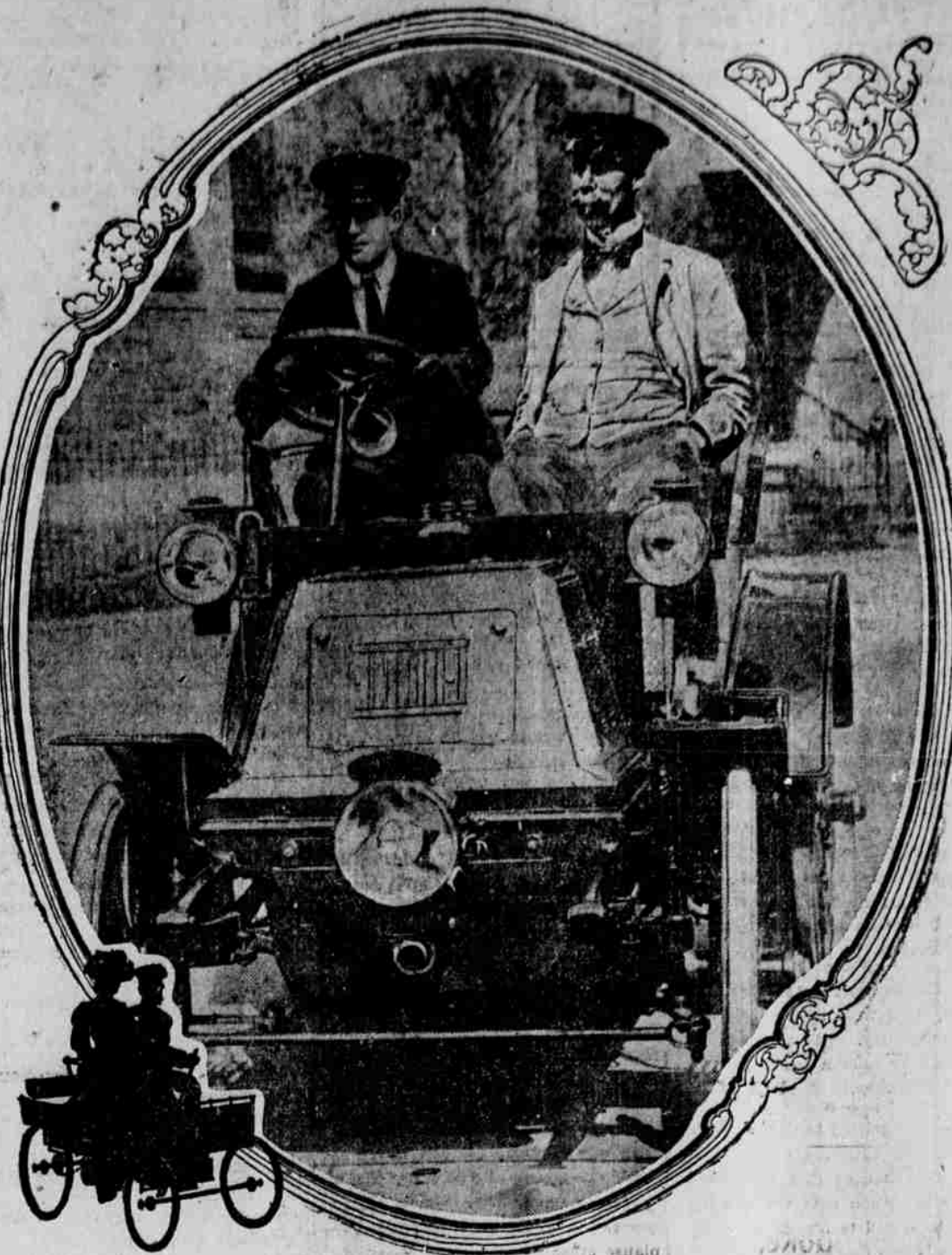

QUOTED FROM THE BIBLE

And the President Also Chose Illustrations Not Frequently Used.

The President's familiarity with the bible may puzzle some of his readers where he refers to the good fortune of Jeshurun, the falling of the tower of Siloam, and the prayer of the Psalmist for neither poverty nor riches, for, except the latter which, by the way, is not the prayer of the Psalmist, but the confession of Agur, the references are not common.

Jeshurun is a timely illustration, however, and the story might be read with profit to anybody. It is found in the twenty-third chapter of Deuteronomy. It is from the song of Moses to the congregation of Israel: "Jeshurun waxed fat."

Of the people of Jeshurun, it is narrated that the Lord "Made him to ride on the high places of the earth, that he might eat the increase of the fields; and He made him to suck honey out of the rock, and oil out of the flinty rock;

"Butter of kine, and milk of sheep, with fat of lambs, and rams of the breed of Bashan, and goats, with the fat of kidneys of wheat; and thou didst drink the pure blood of the grape."

"But Jeshurun waxed fat and kicked: thou art waxen fat, thou art grown thick, thou art covered with fatness; then he forsook God, which made him, and lightly esteemed the rock of his salvation."

"They provoked, sacrificed unto devils, not to God; to gods whom they knew not, to new gods that came newly up."

"And when the Lord saw it he abhorred them."

Moses continues in vigorous language to warn the people as to the results of the follies that came from waxing fat and forgetting seriousness of purpose and earnest effort. "And he was king in Jeshurun when the heads of the people and the tribes of Israel were gathered together."

The reference to the tower of Siloam is explained by the opening verses of the thirteenth chapter of St. Luke.

"There were present at that season some that told him of the Galileans, whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices."

"And Jesus answering said unto them: 'Suppose ye that these Galileans were sinners above all the Galileans, because they suffered such things?'"

"I tell you, nay; but except ye repent, ye shall likewise perish."

"Or those 18, upon whom the tower of Siloam fell, and slew them, think ye that they were sinners above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem?"

"I tell you, nay; but except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish."

The prayer of Agur, the son of Jakeh, is found in the thirtieth chapter of Proverbs. The expression used by the President is in the eighth verse:

"Remove far from me vanity and lies; give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me; lest I be full, and deny thee, and say, Who is the Lord? or lest I be poor, and steal, and take the name of my God in vain."
