In the matter of Dutch Reclamation No. 64, patented by J. H. Leugers et al. To the Lot or Land Owners and to the Corporations, either Public or Private, affected by said improvement.

You, and each of you, are hereby notified that on the 15th day of November, 1910, J. H. Leugers, Auditor of Mercer County, the prayer of which is for the location, deepening, widening and straightening of ditch, the following starting point, route and terminus, to-wit: Commencing in the channel of the Wabash River, in Township 10 North, Range 2 East, Section 26, Township 10 North, Range 2 East, then to follow said Wabash River down stream, to deepen, widen, straighten and relieve the lands there along from the flood water where necessary and practicable, through the lands of said Township 10 North, Range 2 East, and County, to the east line of the incorporated village of Ft. Recovery, Ohio, or to such a point as a good and sufficient outlet is obtained, for the purpose of relieving the lands as herein set out, and there to terminate.

Also, for the deepening, widening and straightening and cleaning out of a branch ditch known as the Vandenbosch Ditch, from its beginning at the point where same enters said Wabash Ditch.
