**Ponca District Is Loyal.**

OKLAHOMA CITY, July 23.—Crude oil production will not be curtailed in any way in the Ponca City field by regulations that may be imposed through the government's taking over control of the oil business in this state, according to expressions of oil men of that field. It is the impression that producers and refiners will not be affected to any great extent, that is by their determination to the fixing of a premium or a stable price on oil. It is estimated that some of the producers will receive as great premiums as they have been getting. They will not reduce their willingness and readiness to get all the production they can.

The present need of petroleum and its products for war purposes is a sufficient stimulus to activity in the Ponca field, in spite of high prices for materials and labor that have prevailed for some time. Producers are anxious to get all the production they can.

During the past week five new wells have been brought in, and one new rig has been set up.

**Transportation Supervisor Makes Good.**  
W. E. MacEwen, supervisor of rail transportation, and a member of the advisory committee on tank cars of the national petroleum war service committee in Tulsa, Mr. MacEwen reports that the rail transportation work as conducted in the mid-continent field has developed such an improvement that the petroleum war service committee decided to have the entire petroleum industry represented, so Mr. MacEwen was appointed supervisor of transportation and Mr. F. W. Voigt, traffic manager of the National Petroleum association, has been appointed as a member of the eastern district with headquarters in New York city, and A. H. Smith regional director of the eastern railroads to work in conjunction with Mr. Voigt to work out a system of handling tank cars which is that which has been so effective in the west.

Mr. MacEwen reports that the average rate of movement for tank cars in the mid-continent field is slightly over 10 miles a day, as against 12 miles average for the year 1917, and that there is a class of a day that traveled at miles in one day. And that there was as of July 21, 2,730 empty tank cars in the mid-continent field.
