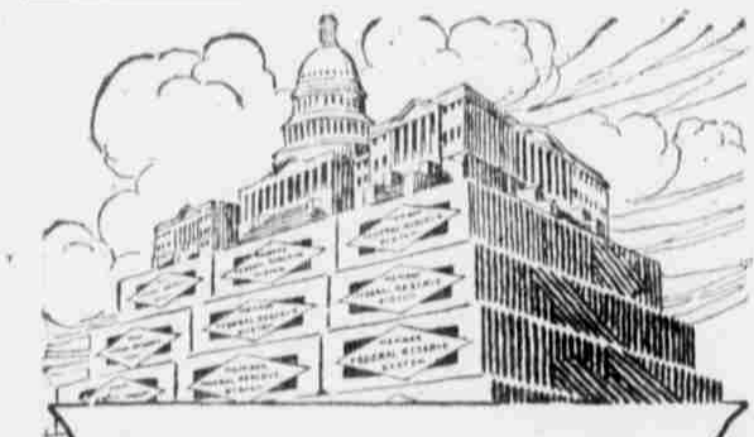


CLAREMORE MAN IS HEAD "Y" REGIMENT
