

PLAINTIFF LOSES IN OIL DECISION

Court Holds That It Is Unlawful to Collect Commission Twice for Deal.

A court decision of particular interest to oil men was that of H. D. Correll against H. G. Goble, in which the plaintiff sought to obtain judgment for \$2,000 in superior court on the ground that he was entitled to the amount of commission for the sale of oil property owned by the defendant near Stone Bluff. The defendant, however, holding that the plaintiff should not collect commission on both the parties to a sale from both sides, the plaintiff's attorney had promised him a backhaul automobile if Correll would find a purchaser for certain oil properties. After the sale, the value of the property was \$100,000, but Correll refused the demand for the backhaul, and the plaintiff, Goble, sued for the amount of the backhaul, which he claimed was \$2,000. The court held that Correll was not entitled to the backhaul, and that Goble had no right to a backhaul.
