OKLAHOMA IS IN FIRST DIVISION

WHERE RICHEST LIVE IS SHOWN IN TABLE PUBLISHED BY NEW YORK ANNALIST.

Oklahoma, the baby state, stands second in the matter of paying income taxes. New York, of course, comes first. New York is always first and Oklahoma is very nearly always second. So far as paying taxes on incomes in excess of \$2,000,000 only thirteen states are listed in that enviable division, New York heading the list and Oklahoma second.

On a show-up afternoon in the quiet north of Broadway, the editor of the New York Annalist, a table appearing in the New York Annalist gives much interesting information. All the states and Alaska, Hawaii and the District of Columbia have residents paying surtaxes on individual incomes up to \$200,000. Then Alaska, Alaska, Mississippi, Nevada, North Dakota, South Carolina, South Dakota and Wyoming drop out. Arkansas, New Mexico and Utah have no body paying on incomes between \$50,000 and \$100,000. Iowa has none with an income above \$300,000. Hawaii, Idaho, Kentucky, Maine, Montana, Nebraska and New Hampshire have no individual incomes above \$500,000. The District of Columbia, Oregon, Virginia, West Virginia and Wisconsin have no incomes in excess of \$1,000,000. California, Colorado, Georgia, Indiana, Minnesota, Missouri, North Carolina, Vermont and Washington have no incomes in excess of \$1,500,000. Only thirteen states pay on incomes in excess of \$2,000,000, ranking in the following order as to surtaxes from this class: New York, Oklahoma, Delaware, Texas, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Michigan, Rhode Island, Illinois, New Jersey and Florida, the latter getting in by the skin of its teeth, its payment being 13 per cent on \$44.

New York leads in every class and in the total. The surprise is that Oklahoma, the baby state, should stand second in the highest class, its payments more than doubling those of Delaware and Texas, trebling those of Pennsylvania and being nearly six times those of Ohio. In fact, its surtaxes from this class equal the total of all the other states, after excluding New York and Pennsylvania. It stands seventh in total payments of individual income taxes, the rank being New York, Pennsylvania, Illinois, Massachusetts, Ohio, New Jersey and Oklahoma. The answer is all nothing else could account for such a showing either in the highest surtaxes or total individual income tax. The surtax on the class of \$2,000,000 and over furnishes \$16,000,000 of the \$167,000,000 total from individual taxes.

NOTED HOTEL BURNS.
Niagara Falls, N. Y., Jan. 5.—The International hotel, one of the oldest hostleries here, was destroyed by fire yesterday. The loss is estimated at \$200,000.

SLAV ARMY MAY EVACUATE PERSIA

BOLSHEVIKI MAKE PROPOSAL TO WITHDRAW TROOPS IF TURKEY WILL DO LIKEWISE.

London, Jan. 5.—The bolshevik foreign minister, Leon Trotsky, is said by the Petrograd correspondent of the Exchange Telegraph company to have sent a communication to the Persian government offering to begin negotiations for the withdrawal of Russian troops from Persian territory, provided Turkey will withdraw hers.

The Russian commission, the correspondent says, has decided to negotiate with the government of Ukraine on the basis of recognition of the new Ukrainian republic, provided it does not hinder bolshevik military operations against General Kaledin, the Cossack leader. It is suggested that the negotiations be held at Smolensk or Vitebsk.

According to the same correspondent, M. Kerensky, the deposed premier, has prepared an account of his services during the period of the first revolution, which will be presented to the constituent assembly. It includes full details of conditions at the front during the June offensive and the reasons why M. Kerensky decided to remove former Emperor Nicholas to Siberia.

In the archives of the Russian foreign office there have been discovered documents of unusual interest dealing with negotiations between Germany and the imperial Russian government in regard to a national convention to combat socialism. Other curious documents relating to the origin of the war throw light on certain aspects of German policy. These papers will be published as soon as they have been classified.

Darville, N. Y., a village of 4,000 inhabitants, closed all stores, banks and factories recently to get in the potato crop from surrounding fields for fear the early snows and wet weather would cause it to rot.
