WILL INVESTIGATE ALL NATATORIUMS

State Health Inspector Receives New Orders From Lewis.

Swimming pools will hereafter be investigated and the opening of new pools reported by Mrs. T. H. Sturgeon, state public health inspector, as a result of an order received yesterday from Dr. A. R. Lewis, state health commissioner of Oklahoma.

Pools should be properly drained and properly kept because contagious diseases have been communicated through water, Mrs. Sturgeon said. Care is of especial importance in the summer when pools are in more use than in the winter.

Mrs. Sturgeon was enthusiastic in her praise of the action taken by women of Coweta Wednesday in forming a women's auxiliary of the chamber of commerce for the purpose of civic improvement, said improvement to include beautifying of the town and changing sanitary conditions. The women's auxiliary was organized following a dinner at which members of the chamber of commerce were hosts to the ladies. Mrs. Sturgeon spoke on sanitation at both the dinner and the meeting of women.

Mrs. Sturgeon gave Coweta a good recommendation when she declared that it was as clean as any town she has ever visited with the exception that it lacks sewage.

States Retain Power. Mr. Walker said today that although the Eech-Cummins act, returning railroads to private ownership, deprived state commissions of much of their authority to regulate rates, it allowed the state to retain the power to require reasonable service from the railroads.

"Because the corporation commission had not been aggressive so far in the exercise of its power over the railroads, the roads seem to forget that we still have power," Mr. Walker said. "I am convinced that a few fines imposed upon the roads would have almost miraculous effect in helping them to find cars for our needs. And it will not be difficult to find glaring cases of faulty service for which to impose fines."

Before writing the letters, Mr. Walker said the commission's attorney examined the Eech-Cummins act

to determine exactly what authority is allowed to state commissions. The letter continued: "This is to advise your companies that this commission will insist upon the observance of orders already promulgated and will entertain formal complaints and issue citations for contempt for any failure to observe them."

Roads Are Blamed. "The fact that the roads are not equipped with cars and motive power to meet the demands is largely their own fault. Depreciation reserves are regularly set aside by the companies and allowed by the regulating authorities for depreciation of equipment, and this money is paid by the public and charged by the companies to operating expenses. If the companies have seen fit to divert this fund to other uses, they should assume the consequences and not transfer the burden to the public in the form of inadequate service."

The corporation commission is in receipt of numerous complaints from various points on account of failure of your companies to furnish cars for loading grain and other commodities.

The letters state that failure to give adequate service renders the railroads rivially liable in damages for any loss sustained.

"It was therefore suggested," the letters continue, "that complaints notify the company in writing as to cars actually required, the time when needed and the probable loss in the event that the cars were not furnished. If the cars are not furnished their rights will be protected."

A car service agent of the corporation commission will be appointed tomorrow to hear complaints from shippers and to take action to obtain relief from the car shortage, Mr. Walker announced.
