## TOLD SECRETS OF MORMONISM

SIGNS AND CEREMONIES REVEALED BY SUPPOSED ELDER.

### CONVERTED TO FAITH IN 1892

"Can" the Password, According to a St. Louis Man—Death the Penalty of Revealing the Inner Workings, He Says.

St. Louis, Nov. 5.—What purports to be a description of the secret signs and grips of the Mormons and the secret religious ceremonies of the Mormon Temple, is given in a book called "Mormonism Exposed," written by Thomas Phillip Marshall of St. Louis, who says he was ordained as a Mormon elder.

Marshall says he was converted to Mormonism in Memphis in 1892, and that he was ordained an elder within a year after his arrival in Salt Lake City. He says that after his initiation at the Temple he was convinced of the iniquity of Mormonism and that he has written the pamphlet against Mormonism to satisfy his conscience.

Of the secret signs and grips, he says: "The signs of the Aaronic and Melchisedec priesthood are as follows: Upon shaking hands, place the thumb over the index finger, press it, then move it into the hollow between the index and middle fingers. The Melchisedec priest extends the fore or index finger along the wrist, over the pulse of the friend with whom he shakes hands.

"There is one more sign by which you may make yourself known to a crowd or even a single person. Raise the right hand as high as the head, palm downward, and say 'Can,' then lower it as low as the shoulder, arm close to the body, and say 'Can,' then drop it to the side, at the same time say 'Can.' For instance, 'Can you inform me' or 'Can you show me,' or 'Can you tell me where I can find.

Marshall's description of the endowment house ceremonials are very similar to those brought out at the Reed Smoot trial. He describes exhaustively and in great detail the religious ceremonials, including a dramatization of the life of Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden, including the appearance of Lucifer and the eating of the apple. He says that he says himself liable to death by revealing these things, as any one who takes the initiation ceremonies has to make a solemn vow that he will accept the penalty of having his throat cut if he reveals anything done in the secret work.

## ELECTION PROCLAMATION.

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Chief Executive of the City of Ardmore, Oklahoma, a special election is hereby called and the same shall be held in said City on the 17th day of November, 1908, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said City a Charter drawn and proposed on the 22nd day of September, 1908, by the legally elected and qualified free-holders for its rejection or adoption by said voters of said City, and those voting for the adoption of said Charter shall have printed on their ballot, "For the adoption of the proposed Charter of said City of Ardmore," and those voting against same shall have printed on their ballot, "Against the adoption of the proposed Charter of the City of Ardmore."

There shall also be submitted to the qualified voters of said City of Ardmore the following separate proposition, to-wit:

At each general election at which a Mayor shall be elected in said City of Ardmore, there shall also be elected a Chief of Police, who shall be at the time of his election not less than twenty-five years of age, and who shall have been a resident of the City of Ardmore for not less than two years. The term of office of the Chief of Police shall be two years.

Those voting for the above proposition shall have printed on their ballot, "Yes." Those voting against said proposition shall have printed on their ballot, "No."

All persons who are legally qualified under the law shall have the right to vote at said election and the judges and clerks of same shall be as follows:

Voting Precinct No. 1.—At the First National Bank Building, and the Judges shall be Dr. W. M. Anderson, L. West and M. J. Hays; Clerks, J. L. Riggin and B. S. Curtis.

Voting Precinct No. 2.—At McCharren's Grocery Store, and the Judges shall be Paul Jones, M. L. Alexander and Guy P. Cobb; Clerks, T. H. Banks and J. C. King.

Voting Precinct No. 3.—At West End Wagon Yard and the Judges shall be Ed Hoffman, R. F. Jordan and J. B. Mansfield; Clerks, Ed Deen and W. C. Kilgore.

Voting Precinct No. 4.—At Hall's Store and the Judges shall be C. P. Hall, F. P. Harlan and Moran Scott; Clerks, O. L. Elvington and Ed Allen.

Voting Precinct No. 5.—At Chancellor Bros. Store and the Judges shall be C. E. Fraley, Sam Danbe and James Smock; Clerks James Chandler and L. N. Murdock.

Precinct No. 6.—At City Hall and the Judges shall be W. M. Robinson, W. P. Poland and George Dashner; Clerks, A. G. Edwards and S. A. Apple.

Voting Precinct No. 7.—At Porter Staples' Store and the Judges shall be Porter Staples, Z. West and W. C. Kendall; Clerks, W. F. Whitehurst and C. O. Bunn.

Voting Precinct No. 8.—At Whittington Hotel, and the Judges shall be J. M. Loyd, C. D. Wortham and Tom Bell; Clerks, F. M. Snyder and M. J. Hays.

Voting Precinct No. 9.—At W. P. Davis' residence and the Judges shall be T. J. Jones, C. B. Ladd and A. F. Pycatt; Clerks, Chas. Cook and J. F. Varnell.

Said Polls shall be opened and closed within the legal hours.

## PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

(Published October 28, 1908.)

State of Oklahoma, Carter County, ss:

It is ordered and directed by the Board of County Commissioners, of Carter County, Oklahoma, that the Sheriff, Justices of the Peace and Constables of Carter County, are hereby commanded to see that no

persons may leave the bounds of the county, moving their personal effects, without having paid their taxes for 1908.

It is further ordered that said officers shall seize enough property of said parties leaving the county, to pay said taxes; and that the County Clerk, upon application, will furnish said officers with a certified copy of said parties' taxes, including their poll tax and road tax, which shall be collected, unless they hold receipt from road overseer covering road tax.

That a copy of this order be mailed to each of the above officers in said County of Carter, and published in the Weekly Ardmoreite until January 1st, 1909.

And that any party wishing to leave Carter County can call on the County Treasurer, in his office, and pay his taxes and save the cost that might be incurred by the officers forcing the collection of his taxes.
