For Salem to build to pave streets, to put up big modern buildings is against the general average of things, and some people are wondering if Salem is really surrounded by the finest agricultural land that ever lay out of doors, and with opportunities and advantages that far exceed a bill before the legislature to construct a new state house. Yes, Salem is getting beyond the necessity of a handout from the legislature, thank you.

The first step in conservation is to exempt timber from taxation. This has been proved a great success in Great Britain. The trusts there got hold of all the land and timber 1,200 years ago, and they have conserved all the timber, and about everything else in sight, and paid no more taxes than the law allowed, and made the laws themselves. Rather than have the timber destroyed they have put up \$15,000,000 campaign fund to keep the taxes off it a while longer. Generous souls!
