A Maryland miller has owned and tended one mill for forty-five years. The Virginia penitentiary is not only self-sustained, but has a balance in its favor of \$11,000.

Mexico is mending. She has had three months of uninterrupted peace, all kinds of business improving in consequence. It is said that Simmons, the Boston collector of Customs, is already very wealthy, having made at least \$120,000 as a Government spy.

A highway robber, captured in Maine the other day, proved to be a graduate from Harvard, but after all his education was a help to him, as he pleaded his own case and got off with three months in jail.

About 3,000,000 bushels of grain, half of which is said to be wheat, are locked up in the Erie Canal. Pittsburg has doubled its corporate debt within two years, besides having expended from four to six millions on streets and avenues. The citizens are beginning to investigate.

The Indians threaten trouble in Manitoba. The chiefs demanded an abrogation of treaties made last fall, by which they reserved were circumscribed. They also complain that the whites are cutting their timber.

Of 700 male convicts once in State Prison at Auburn, 600 were there for crime committed under the influence of liquor; 500 of whom testified that using tobacco was the beginning of their intemperate habits. 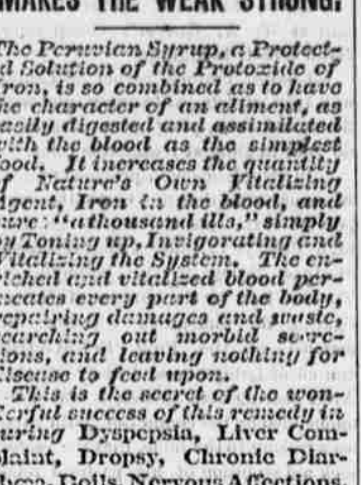
