HARDING URGES CHECK TO BANK COMPETITION

Raising Interest to Lure Deposits Declared Harmful to National Financing

The competitive movement among interior banks to obtain depositors by increasing interest rates is discouraged by Governor W. P. G. Harding.

Another step taken by the Federal Reserve Board was the calling of a conference of governors of Federal Reserve banks here March 22 to discuss interest rates, plans for the Federal Reserve loan and other questions.

Hundreds of banks in interior cities have protested to the board in the last few weeks. It was disclosed, over the action of a few banks in raising rates on checking accounts from 2 to 2 1/2 per cent to prevent the removal of these accounts to New York state banks.

Trenton, March 12.—At the close of last month 17,250,451 pounds of fresh meat were contained in cold storage warehouses in New Jersey.

The supply of fresh fish in storage decreased in February from 81,419 pounds to 124,119 pounds. The poultry supply, 6,912,298 pounds, was about 15,000 pounds in excess of a month ago.
