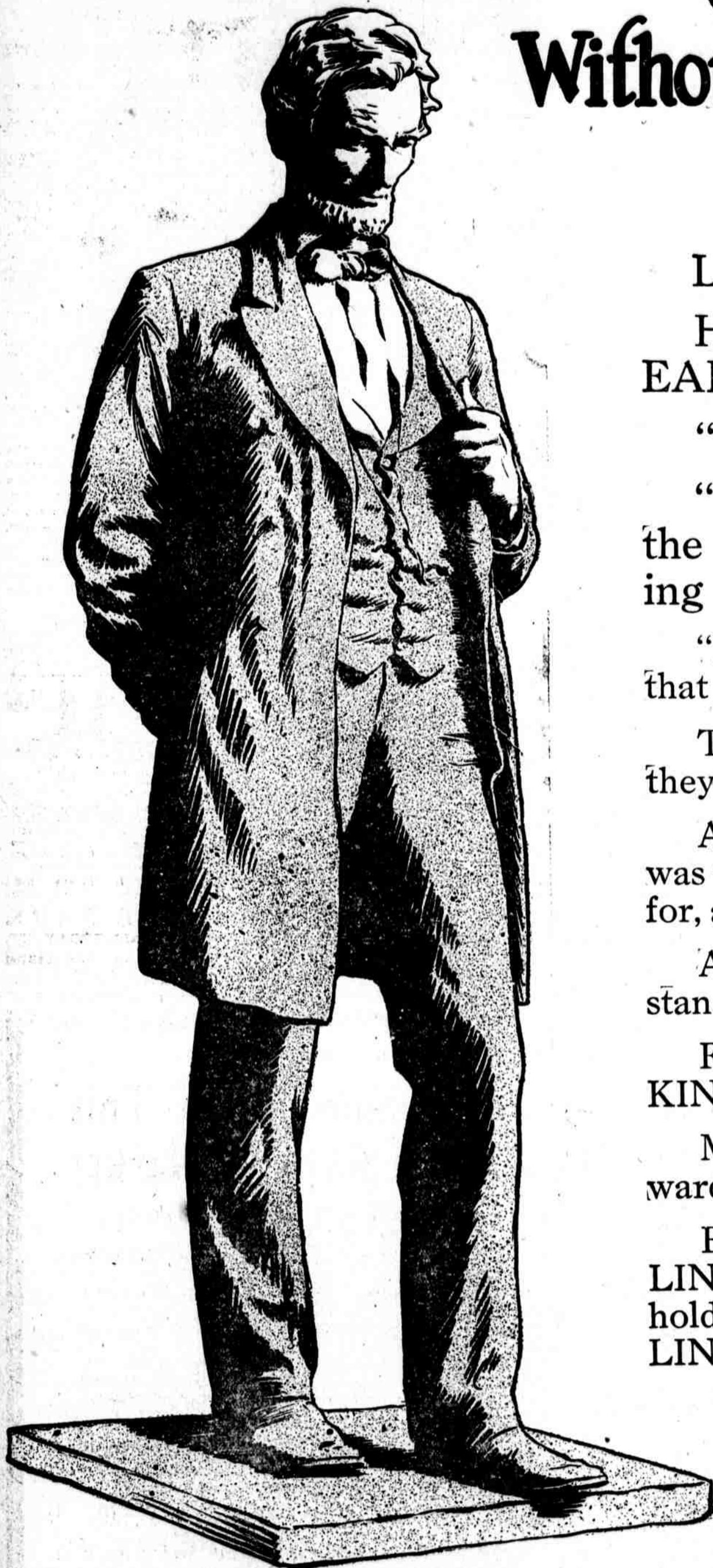


"No Man Is Good Enough To Govern Another Man, Without That Other's Consent"
