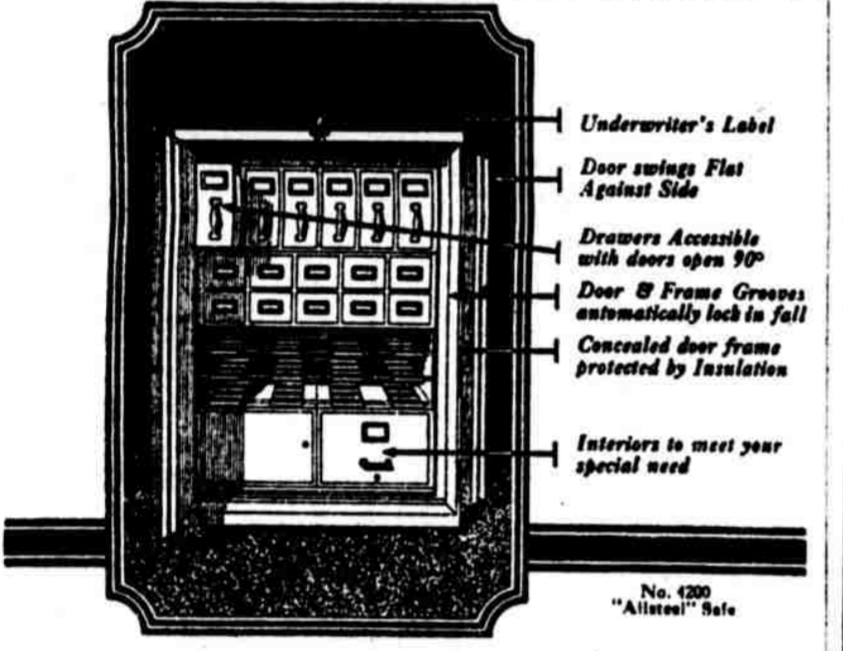

London, March 23.—(By A. P.)—Poor women of Essex are to be given increased facilities for using the divorce courts by new rules before the Supreme Court. Heretofore, a wife could not be admitted as a "poor person" in a matrimonial case if the combined income of herself and her husband exceeded four pounds a week, even if they were living apart.
