that morning. Mrs. Bowers had been ill for some time and her death brings deep sorrow to the community in which she lived. She was about 62 years of age.

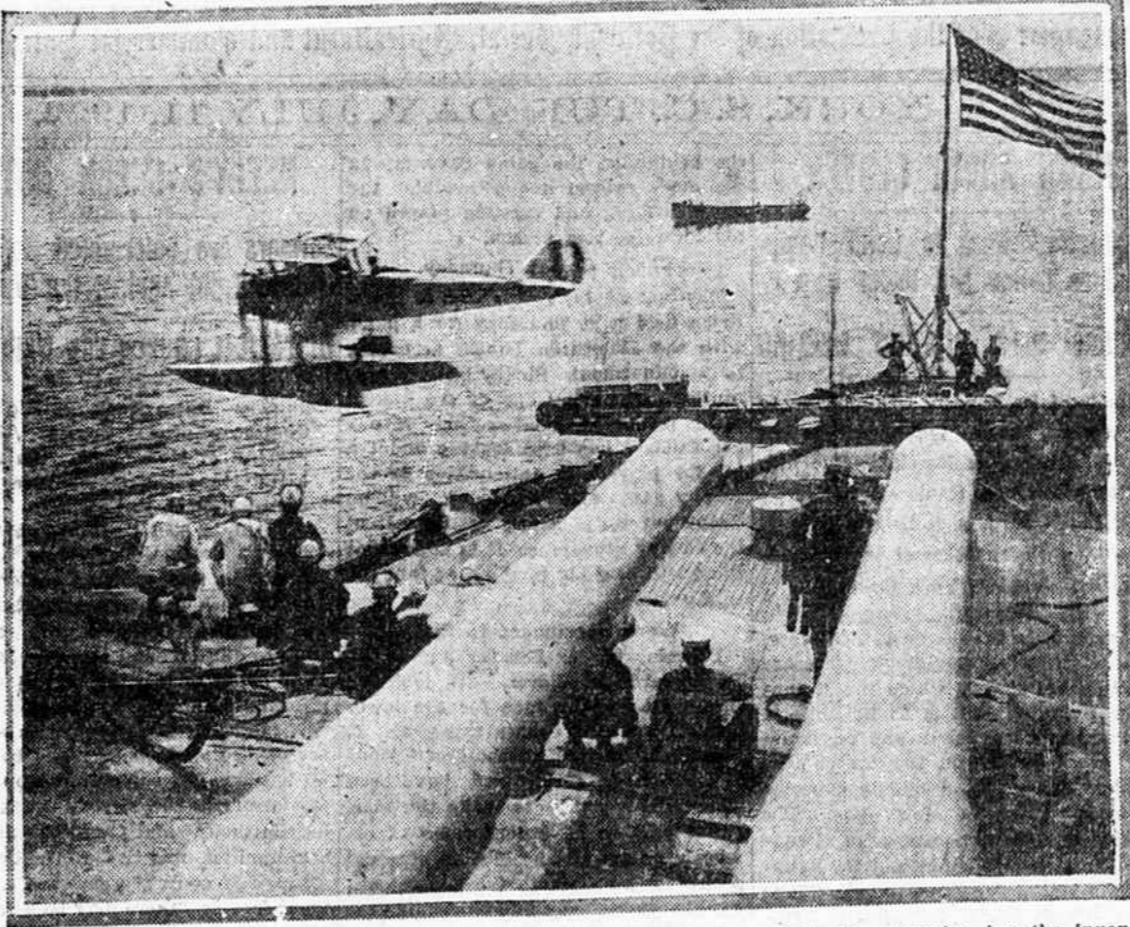

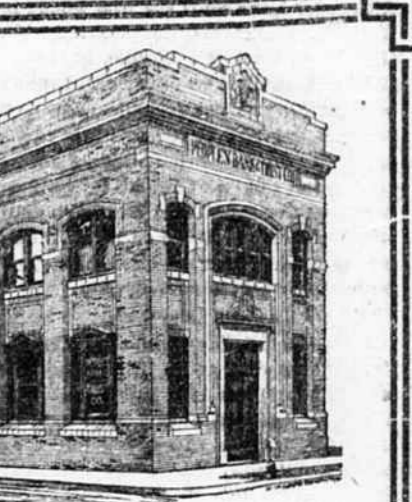
