 Poll Tax, One dollar every male citizen from 21 to 65 years is liable, except Confederate soldiers, who do not pay after 60 years, and those exempted by law.
 Commutation Bond Tax, \$1.50. The last Legislature enacted the following law: "That all able-bodied male persons from the age of twenty-one and fifty years, both inclusive, in the county of Pickens, shall be required to pay one dollar and fifty cents commutation or bond tax, except members of the regular army, navy, coast guard, or military service of this State, and persons who served in the regular army of the United States, and all persons actually employed in the military service of the State and all students who may be attending any school or college at the time when the commutation tax hereabove provided for, shall become due. This tax shall be required to be paid to the County Treasurer of said county, between the 15th day of October and the 15th day of December in each and every year, an annual commutation or bond tax of one dollar and fifty cents per head, and any failure to pay said bond tax shall be a misdemeanor, and the offender, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars and not more than fifty dollars, or imprisoned for not more than thirty days."
 Capitation Dog Tax. All persons owning dogs are required to pay a tax of fifty cents on each dog.
